### Our Commitment & Standards

Reaching every student is at the heart of our mission, and the core of our commitment to building an accessible platform. We evaluate our work against the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA, an international standard which helps us ensure SchoolAI works well for people with a wide range of disabilities. The clearest and most current picture of how SchoolAI performs against these standards is our Accessibility Conformance Report (ACR), based on VPAT® Version 2.5Rev WCAG. ### Evaluation & Resolution Process

We integrate accessibility into every phase of our work, pairing expert review with industry-standard automated checks across design, implementation, releases, and ongoing maintenance.

- **Automated quality assurance checks** run during development and release to catch accessibility issues before they reach students and educators.
- **Manual and automatic audits** run against our live product, so we find issues that surface in day-to-day use.
- **Expert review and triage** apply to every finding, so each issue is validated, assessed for severity and impact, and assigned an owner accountable for timely resolution.

### Scope & Limitations

We cannot guarantee the accessibility of third-party integrations, though accessibility is a key consideration in how we select vendors. We also cannot guarantee the accessibility of user-generated and user-uploaded content. SchoolAI occasionally releases clearly labeled opt-in Beta or Early Access features that have not been fully evaluated for accessibility.
